PROJECT DESCRIPTION Project name: Wall and Woodhouse Brewery Location: Blandford, Dorset

The Hall & Woodhouse Brewery was founded in 1777 by Charles Hall in Blandford Forum, Dorset. It is a family-owned brewery and operates over 230 public houses stretching from Bristol to Exeter and London to Brighton in the South of England under the trading name of Badger Brewery.

PROJECT REQUIREMENTS

The upgrading of the Hall & Woodhouse brewery was an exciting project and the first new brewery the company has built since 1899.

The new £5million brewhouse was designed to produce 12 beers with room for future growth. As such, it required a safe, non-tainting, heavy duty flooring system with excellent heat, chemical and impact resistance.

SIKA SOLUTIONS

The floor surfaces chosen for the project were Sika[®] Ucrete[®] HPQ heavy duty polyurethane colored quartz screed and Sika® Ucrete® UD 200 heavy duty polyurethane screed.

The Sika[®] Ucrete[®] materials were chosen due to their high chemical, abrasion and slip resistance properties, whilst the thermal resistance (80°C at 6mm and 120°C at 9mm) made them an ideal solution for the harsh environment of a brewery.

The first phase completed by Licensed Sika® Ucrete® Applicator, Ancorite, which applied in excess of 1,500m² of Sika® Ucrete® HPQ and Sika® Ucrete® UD 200, whilst in the second phase a further 1800m2 of Sika® Ucrete® UD 200 was laid by Polydeck Resins, another Licensed Sika® Ucrete® Applicator.

They offer a uniform and seamless flooring system that creates a safe and attractive working environment.
